Topic I MORE ON ASSOCIATED MATCH



More on Associated Match

- Associated match is match that a participant is no longer entitled to because of refunded deferrals
- Also referred to as 'Orphaned Match'
- Is NOT the non-vested portion of the ACP refund!
- Amount is forfeited; no vesting applied
- ACP refund amounts are calculated first refunds may take care of associated match



More on Associated Match

 Associated Match amounts are displayed in the ACP Refund block on ftwilliam.com

Associated Match Calculation

- Step I: Calculate ADP refund
- Step 2: Calculate ACP refund
- Step 3: Calculate Adjusted Deferrals
 - Adjusted Deferral = original deferrals less ADP refund
- Step 4: Calculate Maximum Match permitted
 - Apply the match formula to Adjusted Deferrals
- Step 5: Calculate Adjusted Match
 - Adjusted Match = original match less ACP refund
- If the Remaining MT is greater than Max MT then the difference is Associated Match that should be forfeited



Example #1 of Associated Match Calc.

- Plan Matches 50% up to 8% of deferrals
- Catch-up Contributions (CUC) also matched
- Jane HCE, age 55; total deferrals = \$21,000
- John HCE, age 45; total deferrals = \$17,500

Name	Comp	Deferrals	402(g) CUC	% Deferred	Match
Jane	\$260,000	\$17,500	\$3,500	8.076%	\$10,400
John	\$150,000	\$17,500		11.667%	\$6,000





Example #1 of Associated Match Calc.

- ADP test fails; ACP test passes
- Jane & John both need to receive ADP refunds

Name	Refund	ADP CUC	Final Refund	Adjusted Deferrals	Max Match	Original Match	Associated Match Forfeiture
Jane	\$3,000	\$2,000	\$1,000	\$20,000	\$10,000	\$10,400	\$10,400-\$10,000 = \$400
John	\$3,000	0	\$3,000	\$14,500	\$6,000	\$6,000	0

Adjusted deferral % Jane - 7.692% & John - 9.667%



Example #2 of Associated Match Calc.

- Plan Matches 50% up to 8% of deferrals
- John HCE, age 45

Topic 2 **DEALING WITH DUPLICATE CENSUS RECORDS**



Dealing with Duplicate Census Records

- How are duplicate records created?
 - The software uses SSN, or employee number, as the unique identifier for a participant
 - When a new SSN is uploaded the software creates a new census record
- Common scenarios causing duplicates
 - Census from client has a different SSN that was on last year's file
 - Upload from vendor has a different SSN than census from client
 - Other scenarios?



Inside the Census Grid vs. Above the Grid

- All records uploaded to the primary census will be displayed inside the grid
- In second or subsequent year, any records not on the upload will move to above the grid
 - Options to make records inactive and display actives only
- Records uploaded on a vendor transaction file that are not already in the system (inside or above the grid) will be displayed above the grid



Which is the Good Record?

- Census from client has a different SSN that was on last year's file
 - Typically the later SSN is the correct one, but the old one has all the history
 - So the aim is to correct the SSN on the old record and add in the new data
 - If the old SSN is the correct one, just change the SSN on the new record to something obviously fake and delete it. Then re-upload the new year's census file with the correct SSN



Which is the Good Record?

- Upload from vendor has a different SSN than census from client
 - Creates new census record that displays above the grid
 - The record in the census grid has the history, but the record above the grid has the transactions attached



Steps to Merge Participant Records

- Detailed instructions on merging participant records are listed in the forum

- We do plan to add a feature to combine participant records



Avoiding Duplicates

- If you know you have a participant with an incorrect SSN, you can correct it in the census grid (Edit Census screen)
 - Need to do this before uploading a record with the correct SSN – otherwise you'll get a duplicate
- Thoughts on avoiding duplicates?



Using Employee Numbers

- Be sure that you are using the same employee number for a participant each year
- Don't switch between SSN and employee number – once you select which to use you need to stick with it
- Do not use numbers formatted like SSNs in the employee number column
 - Otherwise you can use any numbers so long as they are unique

New Grid Functionality

- New 'System' grids were added to all users' accounts last year
 - Improved design vs. old 'Sample' grids
 - Names begin with '* ftw'
- Grids may now be deleted
 - By designated admins only
 - System grids are an exception
- May we suggest 'spring-cleaning' your grids





- Delete button is available so long as the grid selected is not a system grid
- 'Print List of Grids' link opens list in Excel useful for searching for a grid or grid ID

- Label thoughtfully indicate if a grid is specific to a single plan or group of plans
- Designate one or two associates to 'manage' grids
- Delete any 'empty' or duplicate grids
- Other suggestions from users?



What if I Delete a Grid that's in Use?

- Initially no data displayed on Edit Census screen, though names visible in drop-down
- Software will then switch to default grid
